

Established in 2005 by the Government of Jammu & Kashmir with an initial focus on the Arts stream, Government Degree College for Women, Kathua, expanded its academic offerings to include the Science stream starting from the academic session 2010-11. The college has witnessed a consistent rise in student enrolment, with 975 students in the session 2021-22 and an increased count of 1060 students in the session, 2022-23. Accorded recognition by the University Grants Commission (UGC) under section 2(f), 12(B), and achieving a B+ grade accreditation by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) in 2022, the college boasts a sprawling campus spanning approximately 60 Kanals. This encompasses Administrative, Academic, and Library Blocks, along with well-equipped modern laboratories. The lush green lawns in front of the Academic blocks contribute to а conducive and learner-friendly environment.Infrastructure highlights include ICT-enabled classrooms, а multipurpose hall, an open-air theatre, a browsing center, a computer lab with internet facilities, sports amenities, and well-equipped science laboratories. 




Organisation of One-Day Online workshop on Intellectual Property Rights (IPR)
