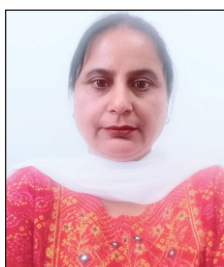

IQAC Quality Initiatives in the College

A. Preparation of Academic/Activity Calendar

The IQAC of Govt. Degree College for women, Kathua prepared the Academic/Activity Calendar for the session 2021-21 at the beginning of the session which reflected all the Academic, Curricular and Extra-Curricular activities to be carried out and implemented in the whole session.

B. Vision, Mission and Values of the College revisited

The Vision, Mission and Values Statement of the college has been revised and framed keeping in view the recent trends in education by the College IQAC Committee.

C. Introduction of New Courses in the Curriculum

The college applied for affiliation of new subjects i.e., Food Science and Quality Control, Music and Public Administration from the University of Jammu. The Director Colleges Development University of Jammu inspected the college campus and granted the affiliation to run the courses Food Science and Technology, Music and Public Administration in the college. These courses shall be introduced from the Session 2022-23 in the curriculum.

D. To Motivate Faculty Members for Publication in Journals of International standards & as per the guidelines of UGC

The college has framed a Research and Development Cell under the umbrella of IQAC that motivates the faculty members to publish their papers in refereed journals of International Standards.

H. Green Practices including Green Audit

i. Environmental Audit

The Environmental Audit of the college campus has been conducted for the session 2020-21 under the supervision of College IQAC Committee by Dr Ajay Sanotra, Assistant Professor in Geography, Mr. Ishfaq Nabi Shah and Dr. Anjali Bala, Lecturer in Environmental Sciences in the college.



ii. Govt. Degree College for women, Kathua organized two day activity under the theme “**Only One Earth**”, a program initiated by Mahatma Gandhi National Council of Rural Education, Dept. of Higher Education, Government of India. On the first day , green teams were made for seed collection in and around the campus for initiating campus nursery. Seeds of Aprajita, Thai basil, Aloe vera, and Curry leaves were sown in nursery by the students which later on will be transplanted to the empty locations of the campus to maintain its greenery. On the second day, teams were made to collect waste across the campus like paper waste, plastic waste, organic waste, glass waste, and metal waste in separate bins and installed those bins in the campus for further use regarding waste management. The program was overlooked by the Esteemed Principal Dr. Sangita Nagari, Dr. Ajay Sanotra, Dr. Deepti Salotra, Prof. Satish Khajuria, and Dr. Usha Kiran under the guidance of IQAC Committee.

I. Preparation and Release of College Newsletter 'Irawati'

K. Awareness on National Education Policy (NEP-20)

The IQAC of Govt. Degree College for women, Kathua conducted an awareness campaign on National Education Policy (NEP) on 16th September 2021. Dr M.S. Pathania, Principal of the college, presented and discussed various features and implementation process of the National Education Policy (NEP). He emphasized upon how the NEP has paved way for transformational reforms in the school and higher education system in the country. New policy promotes Multilingualism in both schools and HEIs. The policy envisages broad based, multi-disciplinary, holistic Under Graduate education with flexible curricula, create combinations of subjects, integration of vocational education and multiple entry and exit points with appropriate certification. UG education can be of 3 or 4 years with multiple exit points and appropriate certification within this period. For example, certificate after 1-year, Advanced Diploma after 2 years, Bachelor's Degree after 3 years and Bachelor's with Research after 4 years. All the staff members were presented and gave their valuable inputs on the said matter.

L. To Establish ICT enabled Classrooms and use for teaching process

All the six classrooms in the college have been provided with Interactive Digital Panels for teaching purposes. All the Interactive Digital Panels have been provided with Inverter connection so that the teaching may not get disturbed during power failure. All the Interactive Digital Panels are regularly used by the faculty for teaching purposes. All the faculty members have been trained to use the Interactive Digital Panels by conducting workshops by the IQAC Committee.

i. Two Day Workshop on ICT

A Two-Day Workshop on ICT was conducted by Internal Quality Assurance Cell of Govt. Degree College for Women Kathua on 17th and 18th Nov. 2022 under the guidance of Dr. M.S Pathania, Principal of the college. The teaching staff of the college participated in the workshop. ii. One Day Workshop on ICT training

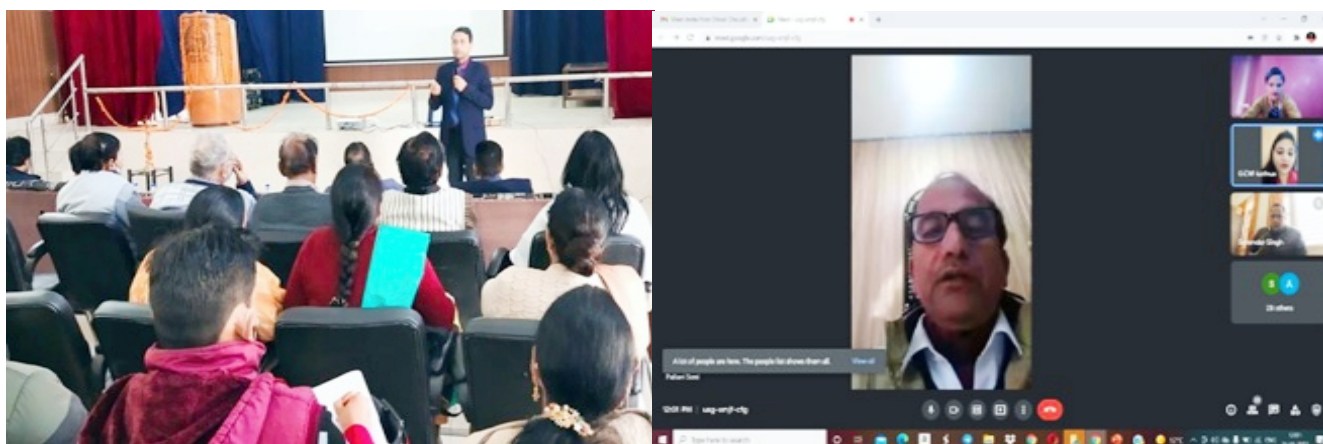

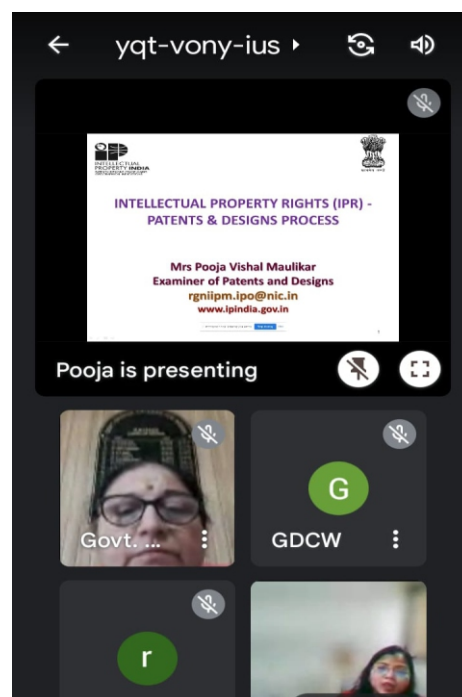


vii. Quiz Competition on “The Fundamental Rights and Fundamental Duties”

a. Plantation Drive and Poster/Slogan Writing Competition

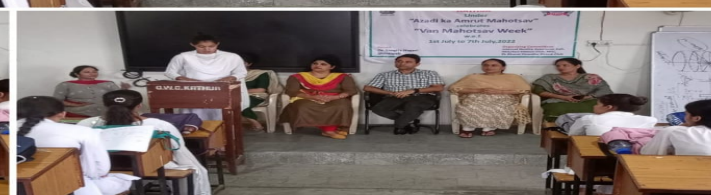
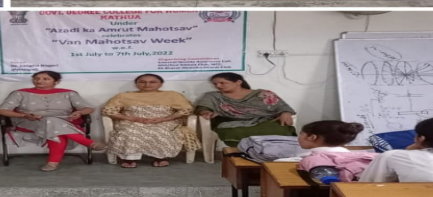

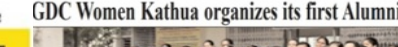


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GDC Women Kathua organizes its first Alumni Meet

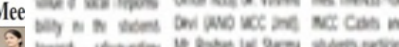


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
