1.	17-07-2025	Summer Internship Programme (Sociology)	As per the requirement of NEP students of semester 5th, Sociology (Major) started their Internship at SPS Police Training School, Kathua. 4.	17-07-2025	Summer Internship Programme (Geography)	Semester 5 <sup>th</sup> , Students from Department of Geography undertook a summer internship at the Chief Agriculture Office, Kathua. This internship provided an excellent opportunity to gain practical knowledge about modern

			agricultural practices and their geographical implications. The programme focused on key areas such as mushroom cultivation, entrepreneurship in agriculture, organic farming, and government schemes related to rural development. Students received hands-on training in mushroom production techniques and learned about its economic viability as a small-scale enterprise. Sessions were also held on sustainable agriculture, soil health, irrigation methods, and the role of technology in enhancing productivity.
5.	17-07-2025	Summer Internship Programme(Political science)	The summer internship programme was conducted at Municipal Council Kathua for the students of 5th semester, Department of Political Science to provide practical knowledge and exposure to the functioning of urban local bodies (ULBs) and to analyse the key challenges they face in effective functioning, delivering services and governance at the grass root level. The internship involved field visits, interactions with officials (Chief Executive Officer, Senior Account Officer Sanitary Inspector, etc.) data collection, and participatory observations. The internship provided valuable insights into the effective functioning and challenges faced by urban local bodies. Strengthening the financial capacity, enhancing transparency, better resource management and promoting citizen participation are crucial for better urban governance.

Botany (Major) started their internship of 15 days to provide experiential learning through analysis and documentation of the Local and wild flora of the Kathua district, with the emphasis on taxonomy and ethno-botanical relevance.
