

1 Please refer to this HQ letter No 4359/Trg Directive/DG NCC/Trg A dated 12 Mar 2018.

2 As per the letter under reference two Swachhta Samaroh were to be conducted between 02 Oct 18 to 31 Jan 19. However as part of Swachhta Hi Seva campaign launched by Ministry of Drinking water and Sanitation, it has been decided to conduct one Swachhta Samaroh from 15 Sep 18 to 02 Oct 18 culminating on Gandhi Jayanti.
